AND NOW A LITTLE INFORMATION ABOUT PERIODONTAL TREATMENT

What are healthy gums?

The roots of your teeth, when healthy, are completely embedded in the jaw bone. The gum overlies the bone and wraps around the teeth forming a collar around the neck of the teeth.

What is periodontal (gum) disease?

Periodontal disease is an infection of the gums that affects the gums and the underlying bone which supports the teeth. Bacteria, which are always present in the mouth, are the cause of this infection, and accumulate on the teeth surfaces after meals and drinks. They form a soft mass called "plaque". Plaque is usually removed by regular teeth cleaning. However, if some plaque remains, an inflammation of the gums may result. This inflammation, if not treated can progress to periodontal disease. In this case the bacteria grow down below the gum margin along the root surface. The bone surrounding the teeth will retract away from the root of the tooth. The gums then detach from the tooth and form so called "pockets". With increasing bone destruction, the tooth will lose its support. If this is left untreated it can lead to tooth loss.



Other factors contributing to gum disease: Gum disease may be influenced, not only by oral health factors, but also by other diseases like diabetes or cardiovascular conditions. Smoking, stress and genetic factors may also support gum disease.

If you have any concerns about your gums or are needing more information, please feel free to talk to your dentist, who can advise you and if necessary, refer you to our periodontist.
